

CPSC 351 — Information about Term Test #2

Time, Duration, and Location

The second CPSC 351 term test will be written from 6:00pm until 7:30pm on Wednesday, November 8. This is a face-to-face test. Students — in both lecture sections — whose family name (that is, “surname”) starts with a letter between “A” and “R” will write the test in **ST 148**. Students — in both lecture sections — whose family name (that is, “surname”) starts with a letter between “S” and “Z” will write the test in **ST 143**.

Material Covered

The test will be based on material introduced in class concerning Turing machines and computability — that is, everything beginning with the lecture on Tuesday, October 3 (Lecture #9) and the tutorial on Tuesday, October 10 and Wednesday, October 11 (Tutorial Exercise #9), and up to the lecture on Tuesday, October 31 (Lecture #17) and the tutorial on Wednesday, November 1, Thursday, November 2 or Friday, November 3 (Tutorial Exercise #14).

Recommended Aids — and Information about What is, and is not, Allowed

Students are asked to prepare a double-sided letter-sized page of notes ahead of time, which they can refer to while the test is being written. No other aids are allowed.

The test must be completed by the student alone — consultation with others about the test material, during the test period, is academic misconduct.
