## **Evaluating Logical AND Expressions**

- •True AND True AND True
- •False AND True AND True
- •True AND True AND True AND True
- •True AND True AND True AND False
- •False AND True AND False AND True AND True AND False AND False AND True AND True

#### **Logical OR** •The correct everyday usage of the OR applies when ATLEAST one condition must be met. •Example: - You have asked for additional help in the course from: the course instructor OR the tutorial instructor. Condition I Condition II •Similar to AND, logical OR can be specified more formally in the form of true table. ## **Evaluating Logical OR Expressions**

•True **OR** True **OR** True

•False OR True OR True

•False OR False OR False OR True

• False **OR** False **OR** False **OR** False

•False OR True OR False OR True OR True OR False OR False OR True OR True



#### **Evaluating More Complex Logical Expressions**

True OR True AND True
NOT (False OR True) OR True
(False AND False) OR (False AND True)
False OR (False OR True) AND False
NOT NOT NOT NOT True
NOT NOT NOT NOT False
NOT NOT NOT False



•Using programs

- Logical operations are often used in searches (database queries – next slide).

#### •Writing programs

- The results of logical expressions can determine what happens when a program is running (more on this later).

(Has quest object) AND (player is alive)
